Motion by Scheuer, supported by Mohr to accept into record the Treasurers Report as presented. MOTION CARRIED.

Motion by Scheuer, supported by Curell to secure Wilkinson Corporation to brine the township roads under their proposed contract. MOTION CARRIED.

There were no zoning permits issued since the last meeting.

Motion by Scheuer, supported by Running to approve sending Board of Review members to the MTA training scheduled on 2-13-17 in Frankenmuth. MOTION CARRIED.

Motion by Curell, supported by Mohr to appoint David Scheuer as Zoning Administrator. MOTION CARRIED.

Various public comments were received including questions about the number of times per year the roads are brined.

As items of correspondence, a letter from the Mayville Library informing us of the appointment of Karen Curell to the Mayville District Public Library board for a term of 4 years, and a report booklet from the Lapeer County Sheriff's Department, were placed on file.
