The Rich Township Board met at the Township Hall. The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Scheuer at 7:00 pm. We recited the Pledge of Allegiance. Guests were welcomed.

Members Present: Curell, Harvey, Mohr, Running, Scheuer. Members Absent: None.

Visitors: Arlene Sullivan, Sherry Emerick, Keith & Mariann Fleckenstein, Mark Jaruzel, Ron Randall.

Motion by Running, supported by Harvey to approve the agenda. MOTION CARRIED.

Motion by Curell, supported by Scheuer to accept into record the minutes of the June meeting as drafted. MOTION CARRIED.

Motion by Curell, supported by Scheuer to accept into record the Treasurers Report as presented and to pay the monthly bills: from the General Fund, \$50,587.27 with checks numbered 12640 through 12657, from the Cemetery Fund, \$1531.51 with check numbers 1076 and 1077, and from the Mosquito Account, \$15,500 with check number 1056. MOTION CARRIED.

We discussed ordinance violations and mosquito abatement.

The July Board of Review will meet Wednesday, July 19, 2017 at 8:30 am at the township hall.

Resolution offered by Curell, supported by Scheuer to authorize the Rich Township Clerk to submit a Grant Application to the State of Michigan on behalf of the Township to purchase new voting equipment. Upon roll call vote, all members voted yes. Resolution on file.

The Planning Commission will hold a public hearing on the proposed Master Plan on Monday, July 17, 2017 at 8 pm. All who are interested are encouraged to attend.

We had discussion about our current assessor situation. Based on the treasurers' research of other townships and assessors, we agreed to raise our current assessors' contract.

Motion by Curell, supported by Harvey to increase our assessors' contract to \$13,000. MOTION CARRIED.

Motion by Harvey, supported by Running to deposit into the General Fund a check received by the treasurer in the amount of \$3166.83 from the Local Community Stabilization Authority. MOTION CARRIED.

Public comments were received regarding mosquito control, whether the township has an ordinance about weeds, and having a generator for the township hall.

Motion by Running, supported by Mohr to adjourn. Meeting adjourned at 8:07 pm.
